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## **Memorial General**

- ♦ The monumental masons have a duty of care to erect memorials securely. Only Stonemasons who agree to accept responsibility for the health and safety of the memorial for the first ten years will be allowed to erect a memorial.
- ◆ The memorial has been manufactured and will be erected to the current minimum National Association of Memorial Mason (NAMM) standards. In the case of headstones this will include a NAMM approved anchor system.
- All work carried out on the memorial (e.g. removed for additional inscription or other repair work) will meet current minimum NAMM standards and in the case of a headstone will include a NAMM approved anchor system.
- ♦ I have explained to the owner of the Grant of Exclusive Rights of Burial (details overleaf) that the memorial remains their property and that they are responsible for keeping it in good and safe condition to current industry and general Health and Safety standards at all times.
- ♦ I have advised the owner to consider insuring the memorial against accidental damage and vandalism.

## Access to the cemetery

- ♦ Memorials should be erected by appointment, within normal working hours and with the presentation of a permit issued by the Town Council.
- ♦ Memorials erected before permits are issued will be removed <u>at the mason's expense</u> until relevant paperwork is submitted.
- The Stonemasons must leave the site clean and tidy.
