Change of Use of redundant barn and surrounding field into themed outdoor activity centre, with ancillary café / toddler play area.

Questions were raised about the validity of the applicant's statement that the barn was redundant and not in use. Members were also concerned over highway safety for pedestrians, the diversion of the Viking Way and the associated but non-planning issues of the viability of the scheme and impact on similar established uses in the Parish. It was considered to be a good idea but in the wrong location. It was Proposed and seconded and subsequently Resolved to object to the application on Highway Safety Grounds.
